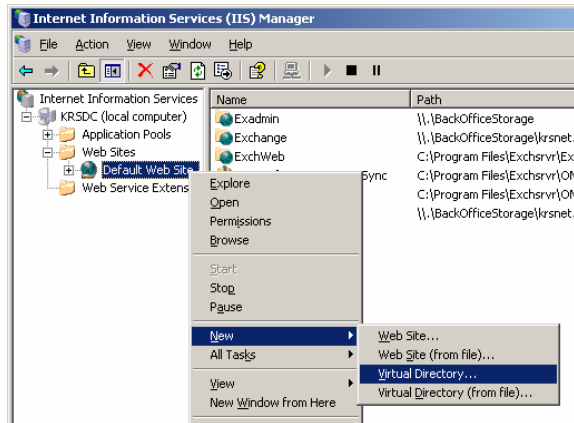
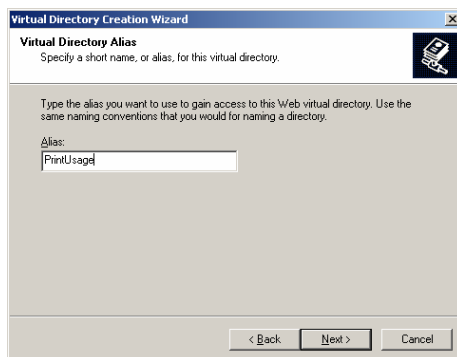


How to Guide for PrintUsage Setup on Windows 2003 with PaperCut and IIS Installed

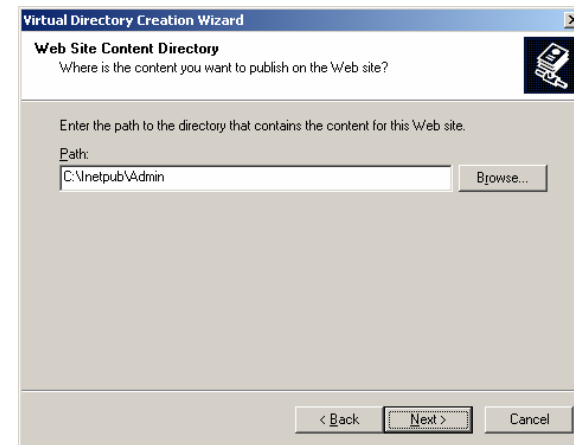
On your PaperCut server first make sure that you have Internet Information Services (IIS) installed then open the *Internet Information Services (IIS) Manager* from the Administrative Tools folder in your start menu or from the folder in Control Panel.



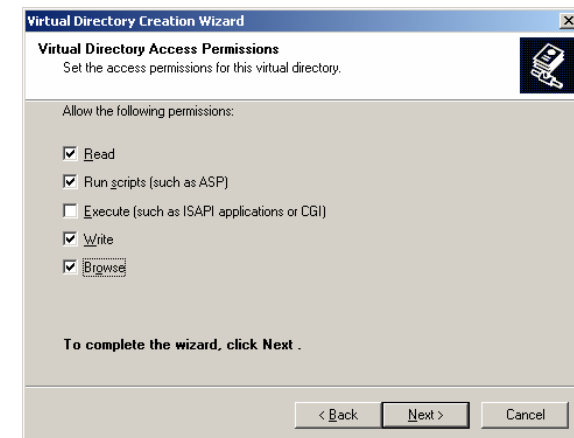
Expand the Web Sites folder and then right click on *Default Web Site*. Click *New* and select *Virtual Directory...* Click *Next* at the welcome screen.



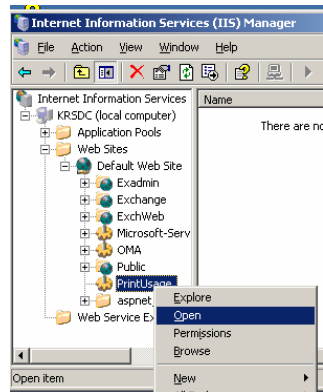
Enter **PrintUsage** as the alias and click *Next*.



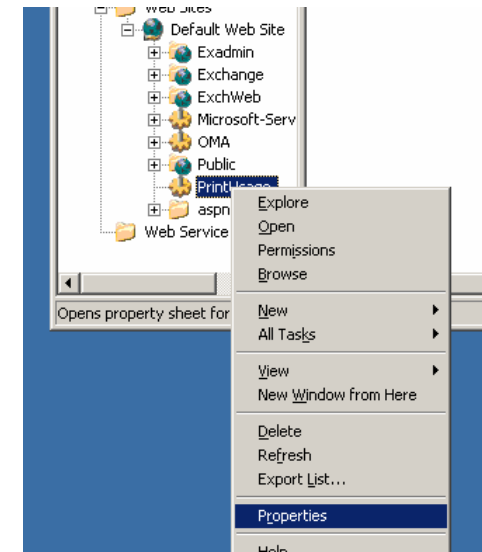
Click the *Browse* button and navigate to the **C:\inetpub** folder, click the *Make New Folder* button and then name the folder **Admin**. Click *Ok* then click *next*.



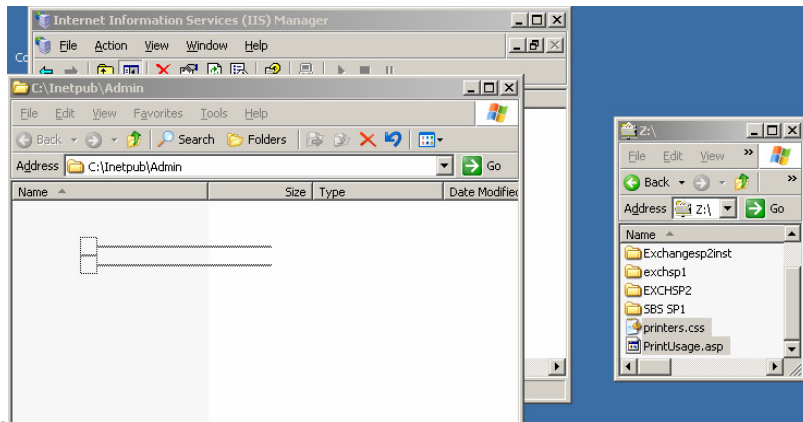
Tick the following permissions boxes; *Read*, *Run Scripts*, *Write* and *Browse* then click *Next* and *Finish* at the final screen.



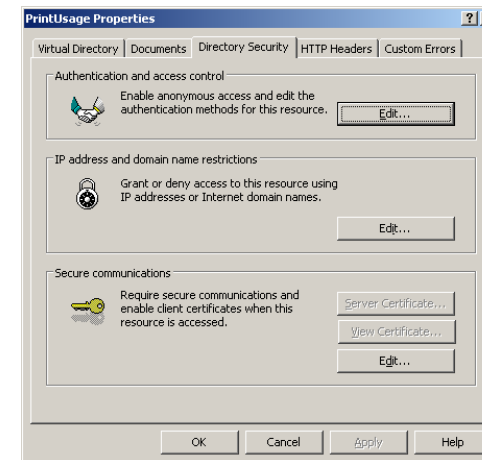
Right click the new *PrintUsage* folder under the Default Web Site then click *Open*



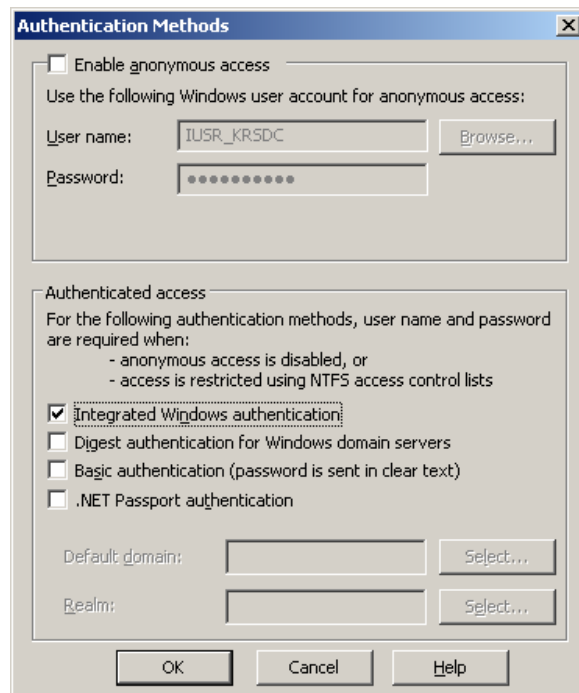
Right click on the *PrintUsage* folder again in IIS and select *Properties*



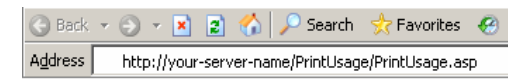
Copy the files from wherever you have extracted them to into the C:\inetpub\Admin folder and then *close* the folder..



Select the *Directory Security* Tab then click the *Edit...* button under *Authentication and access control*.



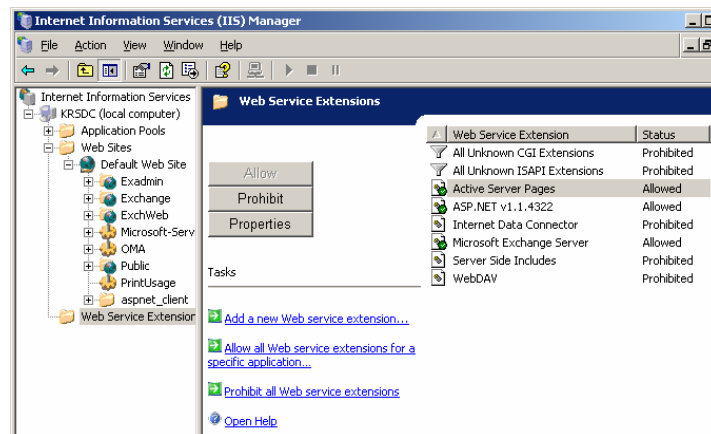
Untick the *Enable anonymous access* box and then tick the *Integrated Windows Authentication* box. Click *Ok*. And then *Ok* again to save the changes to the PrintUsage properties.



You can now close ISS and navigate to the site by opening a browser (preferably on a client computer) and pointing it to **http://(your servers name)/PrintUsage/PrintUsage.asp**
