We are seeking to appoint an enthusiastic and experienced Senior IT Technician to join our IT Support team which currently consists of the Trust Network Manager and two technicians. This role may be suitable for current IT Technicians who have knowledge of working within a school environment or someone who is looking for a new challenge, however we encourage anyone to apply who feels they have the necessary skills and abilities to fulfil the role.

The Champion Education Trust was formed in 2019 and currently has three schools within the Trust. Blackburn Central High School is a mainstream secondary school located in Blackburn. Crosshill School is a secondary special school for students aged 11 to 18 years old and is in the process of relocating to a standalone site in Darwen. Lotus School is a new school that joined the Trust in September 2020. Lotus is a specialist school for children with Social, Emotional and Mental Health as their primary need and continues to grow and thrive during its first academic year.

The Senior Technician role will be based at Blackburn Central High and Crosshill where the majority of the work will take place, however the role will also support Lotus and the central Trust. The suitable candidate will have the opportunity to grow and develop the role as the role progresses and work closely with the Network Manager and the IT Support team, Trust staff and all stakeholders.
